



Lenten Recipes From CRS Rice Bowl

Over the next few weeks we'll share some of the meatless recipes from other countries. Recipes provided by CRS Rice Bowl. Enjoy!!



Mukimo — Kenya

Servings: 4

Ingredients

- 4 large potatoes, chopped
- 1 small onion, diced
- 1-2 cloves crushed garlic
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 3 cups of spinach or other leafy green, chopped
- 1 16-oz bag frozen corn
- 1 16-oz bag frozen peas
- 2 tablespoon fair trade olive oil

Preparation

Place potatoes, onions, garlic and salt in a pot with water to cover the tops of the potatoes. Bring to a boil, then reduce to medium-high heat and simmer until potatoes are tender (about 20 minutes). Add spinach, corn and peas, and cook until water has completely evaporated (about 5 minutes). Add olive oil, salt and pepper to taste, and sauté until spinach is tender. Remove from heat and mash entire mixture until it resembles mashed potatoes.

Eating a simple meal during Lent helps us reflect on the hunger that many people face worldwide. Make a Lenten donation to help ensure all the members of our global family have access to enough nutritious food.
