



**Lenten Recipes From
CRS Rice Bowl**

Over the next few weeks we'll share some of the meatless recipes from other countries. Recipes provided by CRS Rice Bowl. Enjoy!!



Baked Fish – Philippines

Prep Time: 15 min, Cook Time: 15 min
Servings: 4

Ingredients

- 4 tilapia fillets, about 6 oz. each
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- Salt and freshly ground pepper to taste
- 1/3 cup fair trade olive oil
- 1 onion, finely minced
- 1 1/2 cups chopped tomatoes
- 1/2 cup pepper (pimento or red bell), cut into strips
- 1 tablespoon finely minced parsley

Preparation

Preheat oven to 350°F. Season tilapia with lemon juice, salt and pepper. Place in a shallow glass pan and set aside. Heat olive oil in a medium skillet and sauté onions, tomatoes, and pepper until soft. Pour over fish. Sprinkle with parsley. Bake for 25 minutes and serve with rice.
