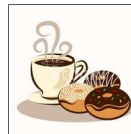

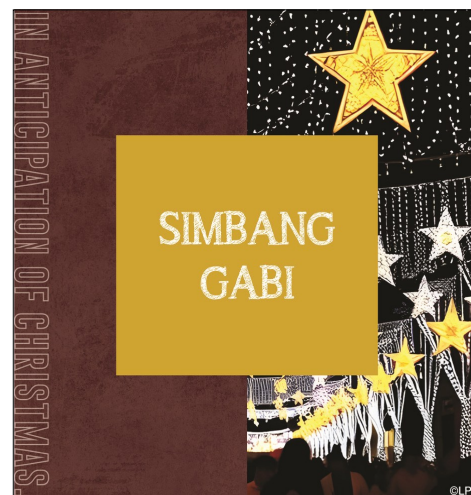

Devotions, Explained!
