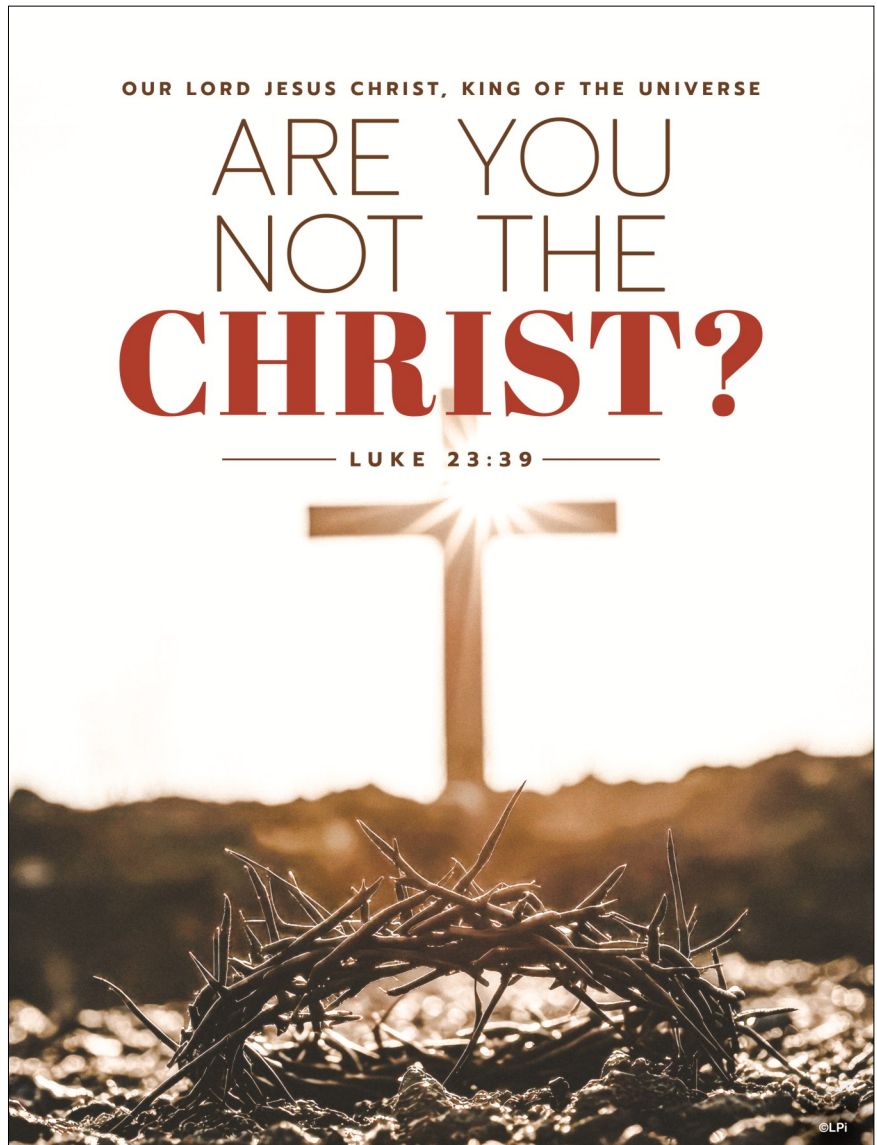

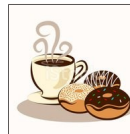

November 28th for the Thanksgiving holiday. The Office will reopen on Monday, December 1 at 7:00am.

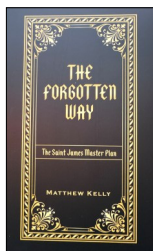


### Poinsettia Sale

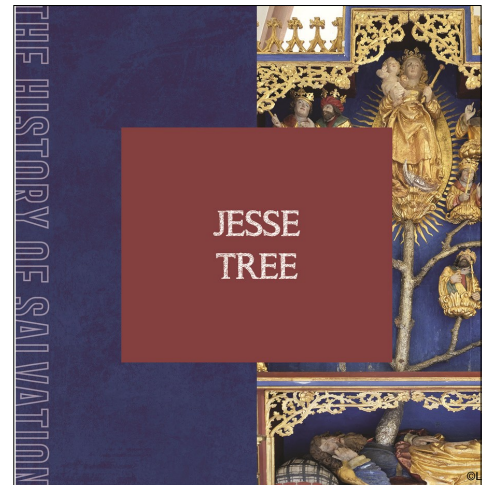
