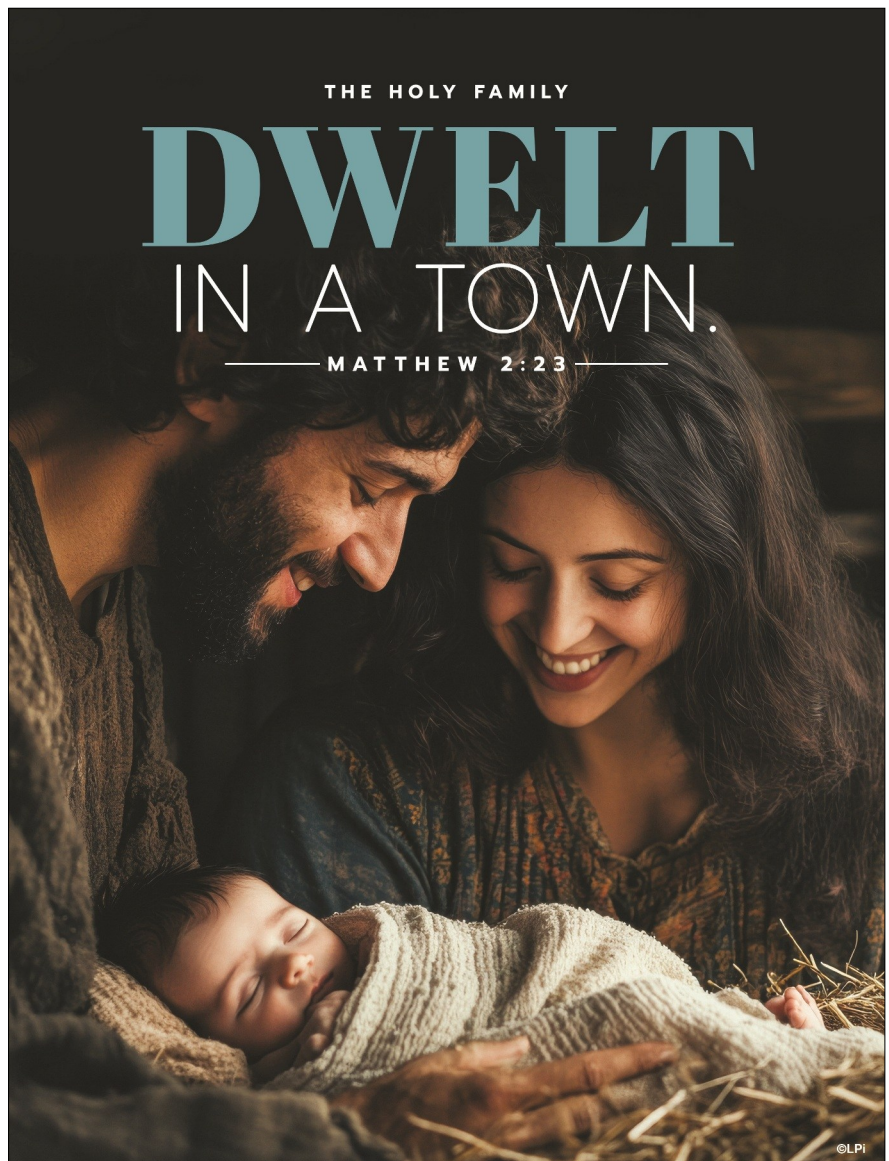

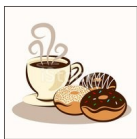


**Family Movie Matinee ...** All are
