Fit the pieces into the puzzle to find what it was.

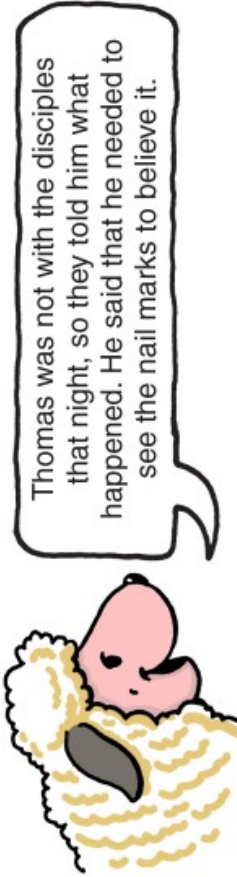
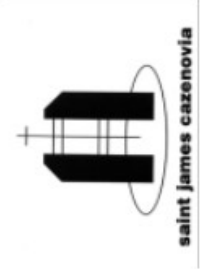

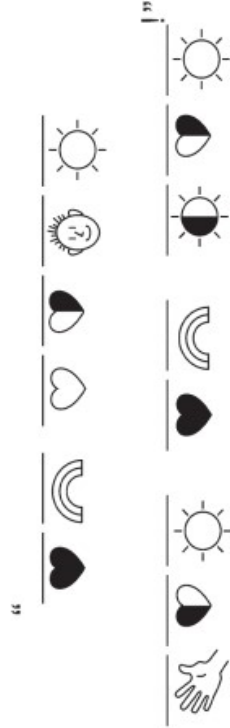
